your Elder before a payment is made.

- ⇒ Registration of new members: The amount of R1000.00 is paid per family when joining the congregation
- ⇒ Annual contributions: An minimum amount of R5000.00 per working member is payable either in monthly instalments or the full amount paid once off at the beginning of the year
- ⇒ Monthly contributions: The annual amount of R5000.00 may be paid in instalments of a R420.00 (R416.67 rounded off). Higher instalments are also acceptable.
- ⇒ Sunday offerings: A minimum of R10.00
- ⇒ Holy Communion: A minimum of R20.00
- ⇒ Birthdays: Contributions are made in this regard as a thanksgiving for one's years of life God has blessed us with. Each congregant to contribute a minimum amount equal to the number of years celebrated multiplied by R10.00. Envelopes are provided during the service for this purpose
- ⇒ Baptism(s): The contribution is a thanksgiving for each child or adult member baptized. Envelopes for this purpose are distributed during service
- ⇒ Confirmations: This contribution is a registration fee for the confirmation class. There are however other costs which are payable which may be discussed during the year.
- ⇒ Harvest: Targets are given to each Ward on an annual basis. For the exact amount payable, please consult your Elder(s)
- ⇒ Rally: Targets are given to each Ward on an annual basis. For the exact amount payable, please consult your elder(s)
- ⇒ Re-a-aga: Targets are given to each Ward on an annual basis. For the exact amount payable, please consult your elder(s)
